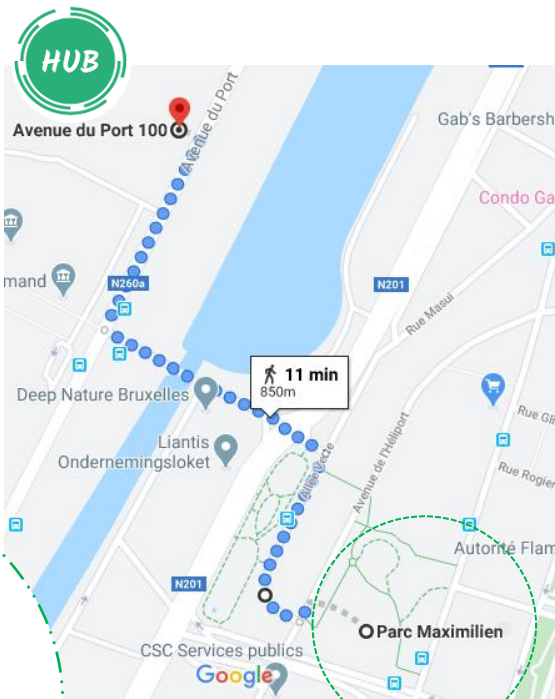


How to get to the Humanitarian Hub ?
